

How to get here

The fastest:

By air with a ticket from your country to Karup Airport, Denmark (the only airport near Viborg). You will have to change at the Copenhagen Airport. Sometimes it's cheaper with one ticket all the way – sometimes you have to buy a separate ticket from Copenhagen to Karup. A good website to search for cheap air tickets is www.norwegian.com - www.momondo.com. (Book early to get the best prices.)

There is a bus, route 716, from Karup Airport to Viborg Bus Terminal. The trip takes about 30 minutes and costs about 30 Dkr. The last bus on weekdays is at 17.45. Check to see if there is a bus connection to your flight – otherwise you will have to take a teletaxi/taxi!

Teletaxi must be booked at least an hour in advance at phone no. +45 8740 8396. The last departure from Karup is at 00.00. The price is about. Dkr 35,00 per person. Please be aware that the driver only accepts Danish money. For an ordinary taxi is the price about Dkr. 300-400.

The cheapest:

If you arrive at Copenhagen Airport there is a low-price bus to Viborg (Dkr. 320, about €43). Monday to Friday the bus will leave from Copenhagen Airport at 15:15 – and arrive at the Viborg Bus Terminal at 20:35. The bus line is 888 – the bus is marked “København-Jylland-Linie 888”. Further information, also online booking, at www.linie888.dk. Look for the timetable Copenhagen – Jutland. NB: You can only book about one month ahead.

IF you take the bus Monday to Thursday and **IF** you have an **International Student Identity Card (ISIC)** with picture and date of expiry, you can get a half price student ticket for the Linie 888 bus. Only the ISIC card is valid for international travellers – not student cards from your individual university. (You will get a Danish student card here, but only after you come.) You buy your ticket on the bus.

The weekend bus schedule is not good from the Copenhagen airport to Viborg. Look at the train schedules. The train only costs about 400 Dkr.

Other travel possibilities:

Train: Information/booking at www.rejseplanen.dk (also in English – see the bottom of the web page). There is a train once an hour from the Copenhagen airport to Jutland. The trip by train takes 5 hours and you have to change once, in Langå. The ticket costs about 400 Dkr. So if you prefer train to bus, or if you have a long wait for the bus, check the train times. Be careful: look for the train trips with only one change.

Please note that all prices quoted are approximate and may be subject to change - and also that it is always a good idea for you to make your own internet searches.
