Library Users

External Borrowers

The library is open to the public, and external borrowers who appear in person can borrow materials.

Library Card

Having been registered as a borrower, the Danish health insurance certificate serves as library card.

Loan Period

The loan period is 14 days. The loan may be extended if the material has not been reserved by other borrowers.

Returning Books

Books to be returned to the library are placed in the red boxes. Books that are not returned in due time will be recalled. If a book has been damaged or is not returned upon repeated overdue notices, the borrower shall replace the book.

Collection of Materials

The library's collection of materials includes the subjects nursing, health care, medicine, health service, nutrition, and adjacent subjects as psychology, social education, philosophy, sociology and management. The lending collection is placed in the library room where computers and printers are accessible – reserved to literature search.

The book collection for the Nutrition and Health Programme is placed in the IT room / reading room.

The Book Base

In the base, you can also reserve borrowed books and renew loans. Books that are in cannot be reserved.

Journals

There is access to Danish and international journals within the library's field. The journals are placed in the IT room / reading room and a number of back volumes in the archive. A list of the journals available at the library is posted on the website.

The journals are not to be borrowed, but it is possible to make photocopies on a photocopier in the basement.

External borrowers may borrow a copy card and subsequently pay for the copies.

VIA UC has access to a number of electronic subscription journals. There is access from all VIA addresses, but not from home yet.

IT Room / Reading Room

The library has a combined IT room / reading room with shelved journals, reference books and statistics. This collection is not to be borrowed. This room has 16 PCs with access to word processing programs, spreadsheets, etc. On occasion, the room is occupied for instruction.
